# Advantages of Bluetooth Low Energy hearing aids



If you have a compatible smart device, please follow the instructions in this booklet to connect your hearing aids to it.









## How to pair your hearing aids with your Apple device

- 1. Turn your hearing aids off.
- 2. Turn on Bluetooth by going to the 'Settings' menu on your Apple device. The slider turns green when you activate Bluetooth.
- 3. Go back to the main Settings menu and then tap on 'Accessibility'.
- 4. Scroll down to 'Hearing Devices'.
- If your hearing aids are already switched on, please restart them. Otherwise, please turn your hearing aids on. This will ensure that your Apple device can detect your hearing aids.








- 6. Tap on 'Pair'. If you have two hearing aids, you will need to accept twice.
- 7. Go to the App Store and search for 'BeMore' for your hearing aids.
- 8. Download the BeMore app. Open it and tap 'Get Started'.
- 9. Follow the instructions on the screen to connect to the app. You are now ready to go.

NOTE: These are the steps and how it looks in iOS 13 and newer

## If you need to re-pair your Apple device

If one or both of your hearing aids have been replaced, you will need to re-pair them to your smart device.

- 1. Start by removing the old hearing aids by going to the Settings menu.
- 2. Scroll down and select 'Accessibility'.
- 3. Select 'Hearing Devices'.
- 4. Select the hearing aids on screen under the 'MFI Hearing Devices' section and tap on 'Forget this device'.
- 5. Restart your new hearing aids and press 'Pair'. You will need to tap 'Pair' twice if you are wearing two hearing aids.



#### How to enjoy Hands-Free Calls for iPhone® and iPad® with danalogic Extend

Function	How to
Answer a call	Use a short press on your hearing aid button or slide to answer on the iPhone/iPad
End a call	Press and hold your hearing aid button for a few seconds to end the call. Alternatively, hang up by tapping the red button on your screen
Second incoming calls	If you are on a call and you have a second call incoming, decline it by using the long press on your hearing aid button or tap 'Decline' on the iPhone or iPad screen
Change the volume	Use the up and down volume buttons on the iPhone or iPad
Turn off hands- free calls in the iOS hearing aid settings	Triple click the iPhone push button to access the iOS hearing aid settings (you can also get access via the Control Centre). Select 'Input Options' then 'Off'









- 1. Go to the Google Play Store, search for BeMore and download the app.
- 2. Once downloaded, open the app and tap 'Get Started'.
- 3. Follow the instructions on the screen to connect to the app. You are now ready to go.





#### If you need to re-pair your Android device

If one or both of your hearing aids have been replaced, you will need to re-pair them to your smart device.

- 1. Swipe down from the top of the screen to open the 'Settings' menu, then hold the Bluetooth icon for 2 seconds.
- 2. Hold the Settings icon for Hearing Aids for 2 seconds.
- 3. Select 'Forget'.
- 4. Open the BeMore app.
- 5. Open the 'BeMore Menu' and select 'Pair new hearing aids'. Then follow the instructions on screen to connect. You are now ready to go.
